Cookies

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as ip address, web browser, operating system, display or language preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

There are other cookies such as targeting cookies which are used to deliver targeted advertising on a website, however we don't use such targeting cookies on this site.
